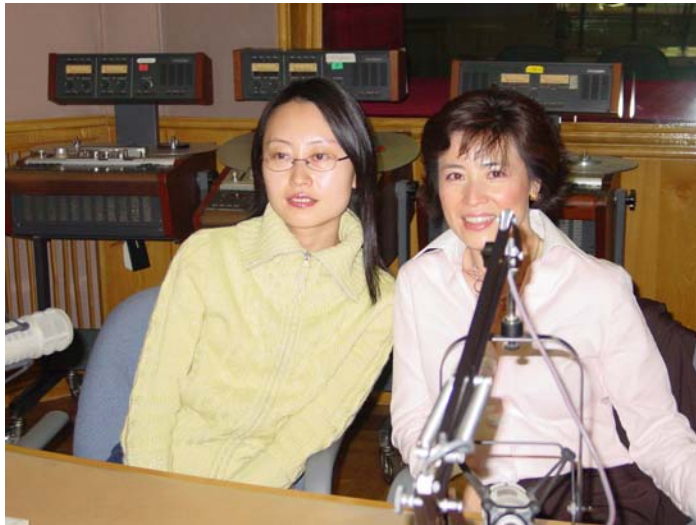


## **Ms. Monita Mo interviewed by National Radio FM96.6 on program “Fortune for Life”**
